Heritage Park Project Will Cause Riverwalk Detour

With the Brownfields cleanup at the proposed Heritage Park on Water Street scheduled to begin later this month, Mayor Gray wants residents to be informed of the impact the project will have on the bike path along the banks of the Back River.

Beginning on April 21st, the public will not have access to the parcel of the path located behind the former Public Works facility at 27 Water Street. An alternative route will be marked to guide the public along the section of Water Street that abuts the former DPW property. The detour will connect to the original route at both the easterly and westerly edges of the property at 27 Water Street.
