COMPOST & BRUSH SITE

Annual stickers allow dumping of unlimited quantities of leaves, grass, trimmings & brush. Brush defined as branches 1" - 3" in diameter & over 1' long, must be in a separate pile, to be dropped off at site. Dumping of stumps, fencing and building materials are NOT permitted.

FEES

Resident Fees:

No Fee for Senior Citizens (65+)
\$15.00 Passenger Vehicles
\$250.00 Commercial-Landscape Vehicles

Out of Town Fees:

\$15.00 Senior Citizens (65+)
\$30.00 Passenger Vehicles
\$500.00 Commercial-Landscape Vehicles

COMPOST STICKER PURCHASE – Three options:

Current Vehicle registration certificates MUST be presented with compost registration form.

- 1) **Mail-In:** Application form; a copy of your vehicle registration; a check and a self-addressed stamped envelope to: Public Works Department, Compost Sticker

- 2) **Mail-In:** Application form; a check and vehicle registration to pick up your sticker at the DPW office after March 13th.
- 3) **Walk-In:** Purchase sticker at DPW Office. We are open Monday through Friday, 7am-3pm.

We do not accept credit cards.

AMESBURY SENIOR CITIZENS

Amesbury Senior Citizens (65+) may obtain one sticker, free of charge, **for their own vehicles.**

THE TOWN RESERVES THE RIGHT TO:

- 1) Issue fines for unauthorized dumping; 2) refuse material if quality or quantity is questionable;
