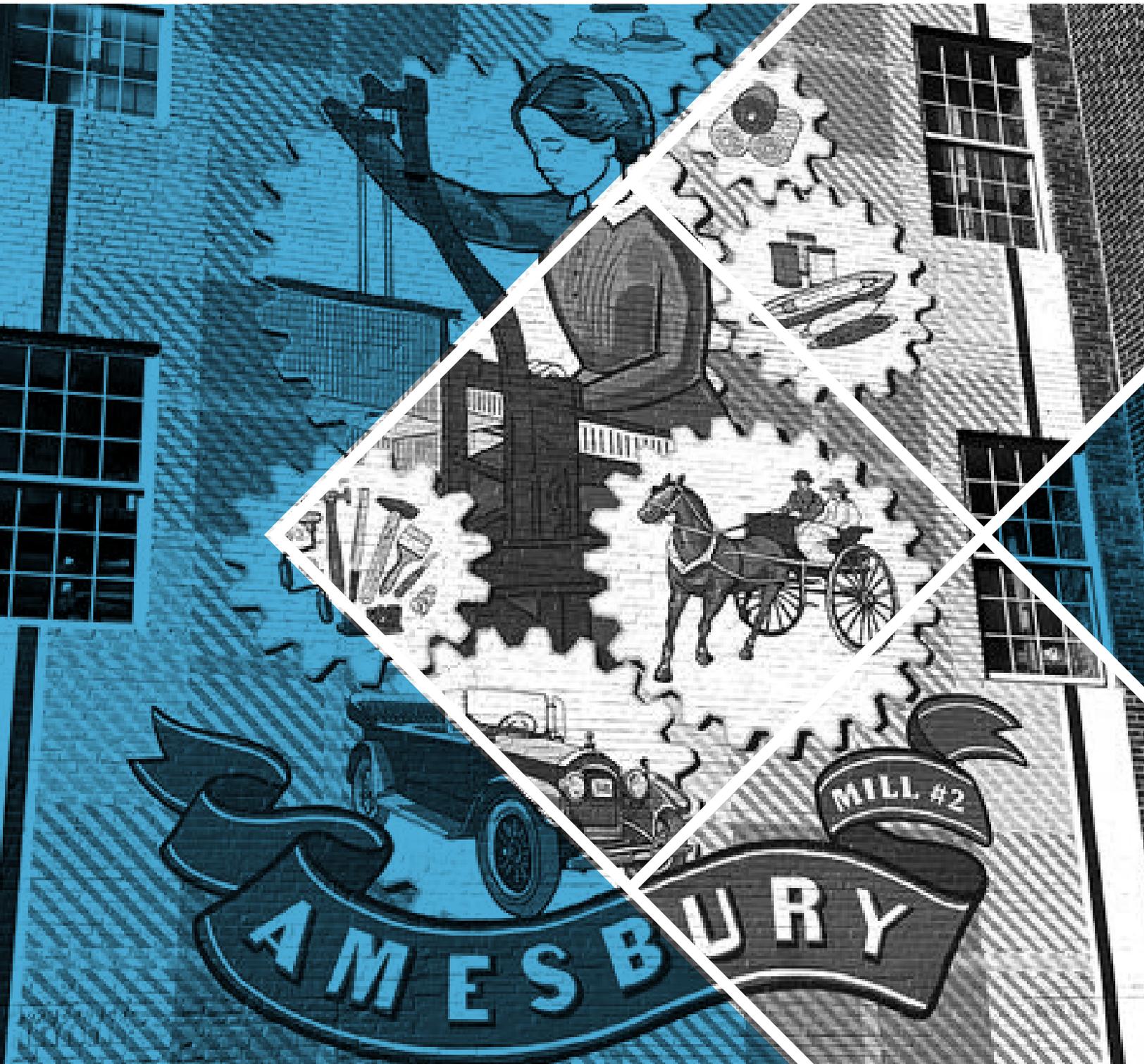

**Financial Reserves Policy (excerpt from City's Approved Financial Policies)**

Undesignated Fund Balance

Undesignated fund balance is the amount of fund balance remaining after reductions for reserves and designated balances. Fund balance is intended to serve as a measure of the financial resources available in the general fund. The City's policy is to maintain an undesignated fund balance in the general fund in an amount equivalent to no less than 10 percent of the operating expenditure budget, with a goal of 15 percent. If the balance falls below 10 percent at the end of the fiscal year, then free cash usage may be reduced to bring the amount up to 10 percent, as described in the free cash policy.

Free Cash

As much as practicable, the City will limit its use of free cash to funding one-time expenditures (like capital projects or emergencies and other unanticipated expenditures).

General Stabilization

The City will endeavor to maintain a minimum balance of five (5) percent of the current operating budget in its general stabilization fund. Withdrawals from the general stabilization fund should only be used to mitigate emergencies or other unanticipated events that cannot be supported by current general fund appropriations. When possible, withdrawals of funds should be limited to the amount available above the 5 percent minimum reserve target level. If any necessary withdrawal drives the balance below the minimum level, the withdrawal should be limited to one-third of the general stabilization fund balance. Further, the Chief Financial Officer will develop a detailed plan to replenish the fund to the minimum level within the next 2 fiscal years.

On behalf of the Amesbury State Legislative Delegation, we hope this message finds you well.

The 194th Legislative Session began in January and will continue through early January 2027. As always, this session has been both busy and productive as we worked together and with colleagues across the Commonwealth to address important issues on behalf of Amesbury residents and communities statewide.

Throughout FY25, we were proud to advocate for and secure funding for the City of Amesbury. This included a \$50,000 earmark for lighting improvements in the downtown area. The city partnered with Amesbury-based business Beautification Through Illumination to complete the Upper Millyard Falls Lighting Project. We are pleased to share that the new lights are now fully operational, regularly enhancing downtown ambiance and shining in support of local and global awareness initiatives.

In addition, we supported Amesbury's successful pursuit of multiple state-funded grants, including:

- \$40,000 from the Community Compact Cabinet IT Grant Program
- \$18,989 from Round 1 of the Department of Fire Services Firefighter Safety Equipment Grant
- \$9,498.50 from Round 2 of the Department of Fire Services Firefighter Safety Equipment Grant
- \$8,099.14 for SAFE and Senior SAFE programs
- \$35,000 to NEMLEC Police Foundation, Inc. for equipment for local police departments
- \$401,654.70 from the MassDOT Complete Streets Funding Program
- \$500,000 from the Community One Stop for Growth MassWorks Infrastructure Program
- \$69,165 from the Executive Office of Elder Affairs FY25 Formula Grant for the Amesbury Council on Aging
- \$12,600 from the Massachusetts Cultural Council for funding for the Amesbury Cultural Council
- \$150,000 for Our Neighbors' Table for equipment and resources
- \$25,000 for The Pettengill House, Inc. for its Individual and Family Stabilization Program

These investments highlight the strong leadership of Mayor Gove and her administration, and we look forward to continuing our close collaboration with the Mayor and the Amesbury City Council. Our shared goal remains clear: to ensure Amesbury has the resources, support, and advocacy it needs to thrive.

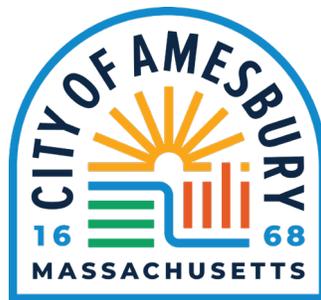
