At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on February 9, 2016 in the City Hall Auditorium the following action was taken:

**An Order to authorize the Mayor to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$525,000 from the Massachusetts Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs.**

Summary: Funding from this grant will be used for the following purposes:

- Design coordination with MassDOT of riverwalk, kayak launch, and bulkhead design
- Permitting/legal costs of riverwalk, kayak launch, and bulkhead design
- LSP remediation permits of riverwalk, kayak launch, and bulkhead design
- Construction of planting and other improvements
- Design of bike trail
- Permitting/legal costs of bike trail


Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
