



An Order to Place on the November 7, 2017 Amesbury Municipal Election Ballot a binding question to prohibit the retail sale of recreational marijuana in Amesbury

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

That the City Clerk shall take all actions necessary to coordinate with the Elections Division of the Massachusetts Secretary of State's Office and with all other applicable governmental bodies having jurisdiction thereover, in order that the November 7, 2017 Amesbury Municipal Election Ballot shall contain a binding question to see if the Voters of Amesbury will vote to prohibit the retail sale of Recreational Marijuana in Amesbury, including without limitation prohibiting the opening and operation of Recreational Marijuana Establishments and Recreational Marijuana Retail Stores. The foregoing actions by the City Clerk shall include without limitation the preparation of an appropriate Warrant for said November 7, 2017 Amesbury Municipal Election containing said binding question in the required format conforming to applicable Massachusetts law.
