At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on December 12, 2017 in the City Hall Auditorium the following action was taken:

**An Ordinance** Relative to the Care, Custody, Control, and Management of the James J. Landry Jr. Memorial Stadium.

**Summary:** This bill proposes the following notable changes relative to the James J. Landry Jr. Memorial Stadium (hereinafter referred to as "Landry Stadium"):

- Dissolution of the Landry Stadium Management Commission;
- Transfer of care, custody, and control of Landry Stadium to the Mayor or his designee;
- Amendment of City Council bill 98-178 to transfer control and management of the Landry Stadium Enterprise Fund to the Mayor or his designee;
- Repeal of two City Council bills relative to Landry Stadium (98-40, 98-174).


**Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:**

1. The following City Council measures are hereby repealed:
  - a. 98-40;
  - b. 98-174.
2. The property known as the James J. Landry Jr. Memorial Stadium is hereby transferred to the Mayor and shall be held under the care, custody, control, and management of the Mayor or his designee.
3. City Council measure 98-178 is hereby amended by striking "Management Committee" and inserting in its place the following language: "Mayor or his designee."
4. The Landry Stadium Management Commission is hereby dissolved.

Councilor Jonathan Sherwood motioned to approve 2017-086 as submitted. Councilor Steven Stanganelli seconded. A roll call vote was taken and it was unanimous.
