At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on April 10, 2018 in the City Hall Auditorium the following action was taken:

An Order to appropriate \$50,000 from the Quality of Life fund (2763) for the design and construction of a tot park in the Upper Millyard.

Summary: This order will fund the design and construction of a tot park in the Upper Millyard pursuant to a recommendation from the Quality of Life Capital Advisory Committee.

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

That \$50,000 is hereby appropriated from the Quality of Life fund (2763) for the design and construction of a tot park in the Upper Millyard.

Councilor Steven Stanganelli moved to amend 2018-025 with a further requirement that the City seek reimbursement grants. Councilor Matthew Einson seconded the amendment. The amendment passed with 5 in favor, 4 opposed. Councilor Joseph McMilleon motioned to approved 2018-025. Councilor Nicholas Wheeler seconded. A roll call vote was taken and it was unanimous.
