





An Order to authorize the Mayor to accept a donation of supplies & labor to install new doors at Amesbury City Hall and Amesbury Police Station

Summary: Act Glass, Inc. of Newton, New Hampshire has offered to donate new glass doors (supplies and labor) for the front of Amesbury City Hall and the Amesbury Police Department at a total value of \$25,000.00. (This company is owned by City Councilor Tim Kisieleski).

Per M.G.L. Ch. 44, Sec 53 A1/2:

“A city council, with the mayor's approval if the charter so provides, or a board of selectmen, or prudential committee or town council may, in its sole discretion and authority, accept gifts of tangible personal property on behalf of the city, town or district from the federal government, a charitable foundation, private corporation, individual, or from the commonwealth or any political subdivision thereof, and may, in its sole discretion and authority, use said gifts, without specific appropriation thereof, for the purpose of such a gift or, if no restrictions are attached to the gift, for such other purposes as it deems advisable.”

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to accept the donation of supplies & labor to install new doors at Amesbury City Hall and Amesbury Police Station, totaling a value of \$25,000.00, per M.G.L. Ch. 44, Sec 53 A1/2.
