





An Order to authorize the Mayor to accept and expend Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act funds

Summary: The City of Amesbury has received \$21,255.73 in funds from the CARES Act for enhanced health investments, specifically to address Medicaid funding needs related to providing ambulance services.

This is a loan that will not require repayment, and the payment amount is based on 2019 Medicare payments to the City. These funds can only be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the Coronavirus and reimbursement against these funds is only for health care related expenses or lost ambulance revenue attributed to Coronavirus.

These funds will be deposited in the Ambulance Fund per guidance from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Revenue (DOR).

**Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled,
and by the authority of the same as follows:**

That the City of Amesbury authorizes the Mayor to accept and expend CARES Act funds in the amount of \$21,255.73
