An Order to create five (5) new, permanent fifteen (15) minute parking spaces throughout downtown Amesbury.

Summary: In 2020, many businesses adapted to COVID restrictions by offering curbside delivery. The City created nine (9) temporary parking spaces throughout downtown to help businesses deliver their products to customers curbside or allow customers to pick up their items quickly. After reaching out to the businesses, we heard back from five of them that the 15-minute space was helpful to their business and they would like it to be a permanent parking space. The five (5) new permanent parking spaces are proposed at:

15 Friend Street
36 Friend Street
35 Friend Street
25 Main Street
40 Market Street

That the City of Amesbury create five (5) new, permanent fifteen (15) minute parking spaces throughout downtown located at 15 Friend Street, 36 Friend Street, 35 Friend Street, 25 Main Street, 40 Market Street.
