


Q1 - Do you live in Amesbury?


Q2 - Where in Amesbury do you live? Please use the District Map to identify your voting district.


Q3 - How long have you lived in Amesbury?


Q13 - Have you participated in recent planning processes in Amesbury, such as the I AMesbury 2030 Community Survey in Spring 2021? - Selected Choice










