Here is the information you requested in regard to the surplus equipment.

1992 E-One Hurricane Ladder Truck

VIN- 4ENDABA88N1009707

- **L-1:** The Ariel ladder is cracked cannot be fixed, Body rot. Vehicle is 30 years old. NFPA standard recommends 20 years in service and retirement after the 20-year mark. Amesbury got about 27 years out of the ladder. The ariel has stress cracks in numerous places. The body is also having issues. New apparatus has many safety features in them now that far exceed the safety standards of this vehicle.

- Located at Newburyport Towing So. Hunt Road Amesbury, MA

1996 KME Renegade Pumper

VIN-1K9AF4281TN058466

- **E-3:** The pump is cracked and cannot find a replacement. The vehicle is 26 years old. NFPA standard recommends 20 years in service and retirement after the 20-year mark. The pump has been replaced once, the dept and KME were lucky to have been able to replace the pump once. The engine was also backed into a pole and suffered a bent frame. The issue was addressed but never totally corrected. E-3 was up at the WTP and now at NBPT Towing. The vehicle became a home for mice, chipmunks, and who knows what while at WTP. New apparatus has many safety features in them now that far exceed the safety standards of this vehicle.

- **C-3:** 2013 Ford Expedition. Command car. 120,000 miles. Extensive body rot, rear gate damaged in crash, failed inspection in July 2022 due to body and safety problems. Last estimate to make it road worthy was \$18K. I would add another \$2K to the estimate for further problems and body work. The value of the car is not the \$20k that would be needed to get it on the road again. Perfect vehicle for training of new people for operations at MVAs requiring extrication.
