



## 2022-23 DOWNTOWN WINTER PARKING PERMITS

- Your parking permit is good for the 2022-23 winter season. A new permit must be obtained next year.
- A sticker does not guarantee a parking spot will be available.
- Sticker should be placed on the driver's side (left) of rear windshield.
- Please park **ONLY** in the designated areas (yellow) during a snow emergency. Even with a sticker, there is no overnight parking allowed outside the designated areas.
- After a snow emergency, vehicles should be moved in a timely manner to allow for plowing of the public lots.
- Blue lights will be turned on during a snow emergency. Amesbury residents can sign up to receive alerts by visiting [www.amesburyma.gov](http://www.amesburyma.gov) or texting "SWIFT911" to "99538" to receive the free mobile app. Those needing assistance with the signup process can call the Mayor's Office at 978-388-8121 x301. The locations of the blue lights are:
  - Old Post Office (100 Main St.)
  - Corner of Main St. and School St.
  - City Hall Parking Lot (62 Friend St.)
  - In front of the Fire Station (9 School St.)
