



Procedure for Obtaining a Second Water Meter

1. The resident is responsible for getting a **licensed plumber** to perform the plumbing work.
2. The licensed plumber must obtain a plumbing permit from Open Gov (<https://www.amesburyma.gov/203/Inspectional-Services>), approved by the Building Inspector's office.
3. The homeowner/plumber must bring the plumbing permit, along with a check in the amount of \$150.00, made payable to the City of Amesbury, to the Department of Public Works at 39 South Hunt Road. A permit for a Second Water Meter will then be processed.
4. Please notify Pennichuck Water at 1-800-553-5191 one week prior to the scheduled installation. The cost for a 5/8" x 3/4" meter and horn is \$400.00 which will be billed on the home owner's next quarterly billing.
5. The plumber will install the meter horn. Plumbers must T-off below the existing meter (see diagram below). A City employee will install the second meter, which will be scheduled through Pennichuck.

All premises supplied with City water shall be metered. The Department of Public Works/Water Department reserves the right to install water meters and charge for all water that passes through the meter.

NOTE: Water will not be turned on in new buildings until the City has installed a water meter and the Plumbing Inspector has certified that the building is in accordance with the Plumbing Regulations. No water shall be turned on/off in any building by anyone other than an employee of the Department of Public Works/Water Department.
