

# Effective November 1, 2022 Curbside Mattress and Box Spring Collection is **NO LONGER** available.

*MA DEP's 2030 Solid Waste Master Plan includes adding mattresses, box springs, and textiles to the list of materials banned from disposal or transport for disposal in Massachusetts.*

Mattress and Box Springs **must be brought** to a G Mello transfer station directly for disposal, for a fee of \$75.00 each.

This ban also includes textiles defined in the regulations as “clothing, footwear, bedding, towels, curtains, fabric, and similar products, except for textiles that are contaminated with mold, bodily fluids, insects, oil, or hazardous substances.”

- ✓ Contaminated textiles may be disposed of in your trash
- ✓ All other textiles, and mattresses, can be donated to places such as The Salvation Army
