







This ordinance will adopt changes to the Amesbury City Council – 13th Session Rules – Rule 5B: Meeting Schedule

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

That the City of Amesbury shall adopt changes to Rule 5B: Meetings of the Rules of Procedure for the Amesbury City Council – 13th Session as previously adopted in 2022-036.

Rule 5B – Meeting Definitions shall be changed as follows:

“The first meeting of each month shall be a regular business meeting of the council.

The second meeting of each month shall be reserved for workshops related to policy proposals, presentations, additional public or staff comments as well as review of old business items or direct questions to the Administration or department staff.

Dog Hearings shall be separate from a regular business meeting and reserved for the second meeting of each month or a special meeting to be scheduled.”
