It is the goal and intent of the City of Amesbury to provide timely, efficient, and cost-effective winter maintenance, snow removal and ice control on the roadways, sidewalks, and parking lots of Amesbury for the safety and benefit of the City's residents and the public.

Direction of all winter maintenance activities for the City of Amesbury is vested with the Director of Public Works, or their designee.

Each weather event will follow the general guidelines below, the Director may deviate from these guidelines if they deem it is in the best interests of the city to do so.

Pre-Storm:

Public Works will monitor the weather each day. If a Storm is predicted, they will follow the Snow Dispatch procedures (Appendix A).

If a Snow Emergency is warranted, a request will be made to the Mayor's Office 12 hours before the storm.

Pretreatment:

When 1"-2" of accumulated snow or ice are expected or as directed by the Amesbury Police Department, Public Works will treat designated routes (Appendix B) if the pre-storm conditions warrant. If the storm subsides operations may end with only this step.

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Snow Clearing:

When snow is expected to accumulate to more than 2” the city will utilize department personnel and contractors to ensure sufficient equipment is available. Employees and contractors will be dispatched according to Appendix A. The city treats certain roads as conditions warrant to keep the roads as safe as possible.

The city is divided into 14 plow routes (Appendix C) and 4 school sidewalk plow routes (Appendix D). Equipment will be assigned to each route to ensure each route is plowed and cleared within 8 hours of the end of the storm. Equipment will be assigned to School Parking Lots as it becomes available toward the storms end. School sidewalks (Appendix D), school parking lots, and municipal parking lots are expected to be plowed within 8 hours of the storms end.

Post Storm Operations:

As instructed by Public Works Director the Highway Department will treat all designated routes as shown on Appendix B. Remaining personnel will be assigned to help with the sidewalk routes (Appendix D) and crosswalk clearing (Appendix E). These operations shall be completed within 24 hours of the storm’s end.

Downtown Cleanup:

Within 96 hours of the storm’s end, if no further snow is predicted for the following 48 hours, the Director shall begin a downtown clearing operation to remove snow from parking lots in the downtown area (Appendix F). Additional operations shall be conducted as needed to clear snow from these areas.

If more than 2" of snow is predicted:

1. Send a recommendation to the Mayor's Office for a snow emergency if needed (typically 6+" of snow predicted) detail when you expect to start and finish plowing 12 hours before storm.
2. Notify all employees and contractors 8 hours before the expected start time of the storm as follows:
 - a. "This is Amesbury DPW. There is a snowstorm expected to begin at **xxx**, please be prepared. I will contact you with further details this morning/afternoon/evening."
3. Call in all employees and contractors when 2+" of snow is expected. Try to give them at least one hours' notice. Here is an example:
 - a. "This is Amesbury DPW. Please come into plow at **xxx**. Please punch in and write your equipment on your timecard. Thank you."
4. Make sure all routes have at least one plow on them using the map or route list, two to three is preferable.

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
