

An Ordinance to adopt changes to Amesbury City Council – 14th Session Rules by revising Rule 6G: Appeal

Summary:

This ordinance will adopt changes to the Amesbury City Council – 14th Session Rules by revising Rule 6G: Appeal

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

That the City of Amesbury shall adopt changes to Rule 6 of the Order of Business of the Rules of Procedure for the Amesbury City Council – 14th Session as previously adopted in 2022-036 by revising Rule 6G – Appeal

Rule 6G – Appeal shall be amended as follows:

Inserting the following sentence at the end of the first paragraph: “The Presiding Officer shall recognize the appeal when made.”

Revising the only sentence in the second paragraph to the following: “Questions of order subject to appeal to the Council, by any motion regularly seconded, shall be put as follows: “Shall the decision of the chair stand as the judgment of the Council?” or words of similar effect may be used.”
