These improvements will provide a more functional space to allow residents and visitors another venue to enjoy sports and the outdoors. Improvements will include but are not limited to:

- Removing existing asphalt surface and basketball hoop and disposing of debris to a proper and legal disposal site;
- Installing new basketball hoop;
- Subgrade preparation;
- Placing new finish asphalt or concrete paving for playing surface with striping;
- Landscaping of the surrounding area as funding allows.

That \$32,699.28 is hereby appropriated from the Quality of Life fund (8020) for the purpose of funding improvements to Collins Street Park.

## **\*Administrative Order\*** **2017-01**

January 6, 2017

Pursuant to Section 6-1(a)(2) of the City Charter, the Quality of Life Capital Advisory Committee (the "Committee") is hereby created and established upon effect of this Order.

The Committee shall consist of five members appointed to two-year terms in accordance with Section 2-3 of the City Charter. One such member shall be a City Councilor.

The Committee shall be charged with advising the Mayor on capital expenditures intended to improve quality of life for the residents of Amesbury and for the community as a whole. The Committee may, from time to time, also be tasked with other miscellaneous duties and responsibilities as assigned by the Mayor.



At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on February 14, 2017, the following action was taken:


Councilor McMilleon moved to approve Administrative order 2017-003 as presented. Councilor McClure seconded. Voted Unanimous – (8) – Yes.




**Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:**

**An Order** to appropriate \$13,000 from the Quality of Life fund (2763) for the repair or replacement of fences overlooking the Powwow River.




