An Order for the City to place Go Slow Children signage at the stop signs at the top of Riverfront Drive – request by resident

Summary: The Amesbury City Council shall request that the City place Go Slow Children signage at the stop signs at the top of Riverfront Drive by the Amesbury DPW.

Whereas a Merrimac Landing resident has requested that the matter of placing Go Slow Children signage in the Merrimac Landing neighborhood, specifically at the Stop sign at the top of Riverfront Drive as there have been numerous incidents of speeding at and near that location, be presented to City Council and in turn, its Planning and Development subcommittee, for consideration.

Whereas, the resident has described multiple driver speeding concerns, including a recent near miss involving a teen driver who was driving too fast.

Whereas the signage request process outlined on the City's website informs residents that permanent signage can be requested via the Amesbury Planning and Development subcommittee, and consideration for that subcommittee's agenda first requires a First Reading referral of a bill from the Amesbury City Council, this bill is hereby presented as that vehicle.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The Amesbury City Council shall request that the City place Go Slow Children signage at the stop signs at the top of Riverfront Drive by the Amesbury DPW.
