An Ordinance for the City to create a crosswalk at Merrimack River Condominiums

Summary: The Amesbury City Council orders that the city create a crosswalk at or near 31 Merrimack Street for the purpose of increasing safety for people crossing between the Merrimack River Condominiums housing units on one side of the street and their condominium parking lot on the other.

Whereas the Merrimack River Condominiums at 31 Merrimack Street are on one side of Merrimack Street and all parking for the units is across the street, the resident requests a traditional striped crosswalk be created to increase the safety of residents as they cross from one side of the street to the other.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:
