At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on February 9, 2021 the following action was taken:

An Order to transfer \$6,700 from Reserve Fund to fund Rocky Hill Road traffic calming measures.

Summary: CNA Stores, Inc. has a Host Community Agreement (HCA) with the City of Amesbury to operate its retail cannabis location. CNA has agreed to make an up-front initial payment of \$6,700 on its Community Impact Fees to cover the cost of improvements to Rocky Hill Road (said work to be performed by the City Department of Public Works).

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

That the City Council votes to transfer \$6,700 from Reserve Fund to fund Rocky Hill Road traffic calming measures.

Councilor Stanganelli moved to approve bill 2021-006 and he was seconded by Councilor Mandeville. A roll call was taken and the motion passed unanimously (9 present).
