At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on February 9, 2021 the following action was taken:

**An Order** to transfer \$1,000 from Reserve Fund to Other Assessments for Amesbury Improvement Association (AIA)

**Summary:** The AIA is an all-volunteer, non-profit organization formed in 1886 to enhance the natural beauty of Amesbury, preserve its history and make it a more attractive place to live and work. In past fiscal years the City has provided a \$1,000 appropriation to support the work of the AIA. This line-item was not funded in error in the FY 21 budget

**Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:**

That the City Council votes to transfer \$1,000 from Reserve Fund to Other Assessments for Amesbury Improvement Association (AIA)
