At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on September 14, 2021 the following action was taken:

**An Order** to authorize the Mayor and City Council to accept and expend American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in accordance with federal guidelines.

These funds may be spent on approved expenditure categories, including but possibly limited to: public health, the economic impacts of the public health emergency, lost public sector revenue, premium pay for essential workers and water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure.


Under MGL Chapter 44, Section 53a, these funds can be accepted and expended by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.


**Be it ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:**

That the Mayor is authorized by the City Council to accept and expend American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in accordance with federal guidelines (on approved expenditure categories, including but not possibly limited to: public health, the economic impacts of the public health emergency, lost public sector revenue, premium pay for essential workers and water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure), and consistent with the requirements of MGL Chapter 44, Section 53a.

Councilor Gilday moved to accept 2021-100 as presented and was seconded by Councilor Hogg. The motion passed unanimously (6 present- Rinaldi, Wheeler, & Kisieleski not present).
