At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on October 12, 2021 the following action was taken:

An Order to authorize the Mayor to accept and expend a FY20 Assistance to Firefighters (AFG) Grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for an aerial ladder truck.

Summary: This AFG grant from FEMA (in the amount of \$947,619.05), with a City of Amesbury match of 5% of Federal funds awarded (\$47,380.95), totals \$995,000.00 to fund purchase of an aerial ladder truck for the Amesbury Fire Department. This NFPA 1901 compliant quint-type aerial ladder, with a minimum of 100-foot aerial ladder and 1500-gpm pump, will carry up to six (6) firefighters.

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

That the City of Amesbury authorizes the Mayor to accept and expend a FY20 AFG Grant of \$947,619.05 from FEMA for an aerial ladder truck.

Councilor Stanganelli moved to approve bill 2021-127 as presented and he was seconded by Councilor Rinaldi. The motion passed unanimously (9 present).
