At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on November 9, 2021 the following action was taken:

An Order to authorize the Mayor to expend a Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) grant to replace the Amesbury Elementary School (AES) with a new building.

Summary: This grant (of up to \$23,942,384) from MSBA was received in September 2019. It was never submitted to City Council for acceptance and authorization to spend by the previous administration.

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

That the City of Amesbury authorizes the Mayor to expend a Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) grant to replace the Amesbury Elementary School (AES) with a new building for an amount not to exceed \$23,942,384.

Councilor Mandeville moved to approve bill 2021-138, and he was seconded by Councilor Wheeler. A roll call vote was taken and the motion passed (7 in favor, Lennon abstained, Stanganelli no).
