Congratulations!! You all are recipients of a Legislative Earmark Grant Award in Fiscal Year 2022; Chapter 24 of the Acts of 2021. The Executive Office of Elder Affairs (EOEA) is finalizing the contractual documents for distribution sometime next week. I would just like to mention a few housekeeping items pre circulation.

Expenses or services incurred under the FY22 Earmark Contracts will include the following dates of service:
7/1/20 to 6/30/21

1. Earmark Contract Packet consists of 3 pages; Standard Contract Form (SCF) and two supporting documents.
2. The SCF is signed by a person who has the authority to execute contracts within the Commonwealth. Usually a Mayor, Town Administrator, Select Board member and the like.
3. You will receive the Standard Contract Form as a 'mail merge' file. The attachment will include 28 different SCFs, one for each recipient. There will be a second attachment of a 'mail merge' file for the supporting documents.
