At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on November 9, 2021 the following action was taken:

An Order to authorize the Mayor to expend, for its second year, a Drug Free Communities Support Program Grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDCP).

Summary: This \$125,000.00 Federal grant from HHS/CDCP will continue to fund the Partnership of Amesbury Community and Teens (PACT) Coalition's Substance Abuse Prevention Program. This grant addresses two major goals: to establish and strengthen collaboration among communities, public and private non-profit agencies, and Federal, state, local and tribal governments to support the efforts of community coalitions; and to reduce substance use among youth and, over time, among adults.

This project has a total yearly value of \$250,090.00, with \$125,090.00 of non-federal City match, and has been approved from December 31, 2020 through September 29, 2025. It is anticipated that the grant may be renewed beyond the end of this period if the program achieves demonstrated success.

Be it Ordered by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

That the City of Amesbury authorizes the Mayor to expend, for its second year, a Drug Free Communities Support Program Grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDCP) in the amount of \$125,000.00.

Councilor Wheeler moved to approve bill 2021-142, and was seconded by Councilor Hogg. A roll call vote was taken and it was voted unanimous (9 present).
