At the meeting of the Amesbury City Council held on November 9, 2021 the following action was taken:

**An Ordinance** to authorize the City to create an Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station Revolving Fund for the collection of revenue obtained from sponsorships of advertising on EV charging stations and energy sales revenue.

**Summary:** In order to fund the maintenance contract for the eight (8) EV stations currently in Amesbury, the City, through the efforts of the Energy Committee, will solicit and contract with local business owners for advertisement on the EV charging stations. This revenue will also allow the City to reduce the cost of the energy dispensed during a charging session, making the stations more attractive to potential users.

**Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Amesbury assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:**


That Section 20-24 of the City ordinances, titled "Establishment of revolving funds" is hereby amended by adding the following:
