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OBSTRUCTION PERMIT

An obstruction permit is required to block a portion of Town property. The following information must accompany the permit request:

- A Certificate of Liability – up to \$100,000.00
- A diagram with widths and lengths of the obstruction.

This permit expires in 30 days. If the area is blocked for more than three (3) days, a temporary walkway must be installed to allow pedestrians to pass, as referenced in Town By-law, Article 17. Non-compliance of this by-law shall result in a penalty fee of up to \$300.00.

Subject to the conditions and stipulations hereinafter mentioned and the provisions of Article 17 of the By-laws of the Town of Amesbury. In consideration of the granting of this permit, the Applicant for him/herself, his/her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, agrees to indemnify and to save harmless the Town of Amesbury against and from all damages by reason of cost or expense it may suffer, or be put to by reason of any claim for damages or be reason of any proceeding, criminal or civil, on account of the existence of any obstruction, excavation or other condition or act growing out of any work or thing done under this permit. The Applicant does hereby further agree that during the above-mentioned work, he/she will comply with all provisions of law with reference to warning indications and barriers, and to exercise due care and precaution against any and all accidents, and that upon completion of the work, will at his/her own expense restore the street, sidewalk or way to a condition satisfactory to the Dept. of Public Works. The obstruction site shall not interfere with snow/ice operations.
