

Emergency City Council Meeting
Minutes
Tuesday, April 28, 2015
City Hall Auditorium

Council President McMilleon called the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilor Bartley.

Roll call was taken.

The following were present: Councilor Bartley, Councilor Lavoie, Councilor McClure, Councilor Sherwood, Councilor Sickorez and Councilor McMilleon. Councilor Moavenzadeh arrived at 6:37 p.m. Councilor Ferguson and Councilor Bezanson had excused absences.

Councilor McMilleon read the emergency preamble.

Councilor Jonathan Sherwood moved to accept as an Emergency measure the measure before the Council and accept the Emergency Preamble. Councilor Bartley seconded. Roll Call Vote – 6-Yes (6 members present - Councilor Bartley, Councilor Lavoie, Councilor McClure, Councilor Sherwood, Councilor Sickorez, Councilor McMilleon)

2015-039 An Emergency Measure to authorize a transfer of \$14,600 from (132) Reserve Fund to (220) Fire Department – Capital

Deputy Chief Fournier explained that on March 22, 2015, the water pump on Engine 2 failed. It cannot be driven. They are using a reserve engine (Engine 3) in its place. The water pump is not under warranty. He said that the trucks are maintained and serviced on a regular basis. The truck will take approximately a week to get it repaired.

Chuck Benevento said that there is \$50,000 in the reserve fund.

Councilor McClure moved to approve 2015-039 as written. Councilor Bartley seconded. Roll Call Vote – 7 Yes (7 members present - Councilor Bartley, Councilor Lavoie, Councilor McClure, Councilor Moavenzadeh, Councilor Sherwood, Councilor Sickorez, Councilor McMilleon)

Councilor Sickorez moved to adjourn at 6:45 p.m. Councilor McClure seconded. It was voted unanimous.
